# Physically Prepare

- Select hymns early.
- Send selections to the piano player/instrumentalist.
- Rehearse/Practice hymns.
- Get adequate rest.
- Plan to arrive at meeting location early.
- Be aware of where piano player and instrumentalist are seated.

- Order of the hymns, type, style, tempo and meaning of the hymns
- Communicate any changes made to the schedule









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

## Ending each verse and the hymn (Hymn 112)



#### **HOLD** options

Directing the last beat in the previous measure is modified to allow one of the following "hold' positions

- Hold hand to the start position of the hymn.
- Or hold hand out to the congregation

#### **CUT**

Controlled circular motion

- (out-in-out) -

Followed by

Closing of the finger and thumb or a distinct bounce at the end.
